Entering the fourth quarter with a 16-point deficit, the Liberty brought the game within two points in the final two minutes, but was unable to overcome the Mystics ... New York led after one quarter of play 14-12, but Washington poured in 20 points in the next frame ... Back to back treys from the Mystics pushed the hosts ahead 32-28 at the break ... With a 14-5 run to open the third period, Washington went ahead by 10 ... The Liberty came alive in the fourth quarter to battle back ... Cathrine Kraayeveld's lay-up with 1:19 remaining pulled New York within two points ... Alana Beard's jumper with 39.9 seconds to go put the Mystics up four ... With 23.2 on the game clock, Shameka Christon sunk a jump shot and was fouled by Chasity Melvin to give New York hope once again ... However, Christon's free throw was off mark and Washington regained possession ... Kraayeveld sent Lindsey Harding to the charity stripe with 8.2 seconds remaining ... After Harding connected on both to net a game-high 23 points, Christon made a three pointer at the buzzer, but it was not enough ... Christon finished with 21 points.

**07/30**  
**WAS 78, NY 75**

The Liberty battled back from a 22-point third-quarter deficit behind the play of Janel McCarville, but the Mystics pulled away in the final seconds to take the win ... It was with 3:05 to go in the game that McCarville's pair of free throws pulled New York within two points ... Alana Beard sunk a jumper almost a minute later ... When Beard was sent to the line with 1:42 remaining, she pushed the Mystics ahead by five ... The first half saw a scoring surge from the visitors, taking a commanding 34-12 lead in the opening frame ... New York trailed by 18 points heading into the break ... McCarville's 28 points were a season-high.

**08/16**  
**NY 60, WAS 59**

Janel McCarville's free throw with 9.1 seconds remaining lifted the Liberty over the Mystics for just the first time this season ... Leading at half-time, 31-23, New York was held to just nine points in the third frame as Washington poured on a scoring barrage to take control of the game ... Cathrine Kraayeveld's three pointer with 3:29 left in the fourth quarter pushed the Liberty back on top 53-52 ... Alana Beard answered with a trey of her own with 2:51 to go to tie the game at 55 ... Shameka Christon sent Lindsey Harding to the free throw line less than a minute later to give the lead back to the hosts ... It wasn't until 44.3 seconds in the game that the Liberty was able to tie the game again at 57 ... Beard once again pushed the Mystics ahead by two with 23.3 ... In the next possession, New York worked the ball to McCarville, who tossed up a one-handed off-balance floating shot from the lane and was fouled by Crystal Langhorne, which led to the winning free throw ... McCarville finished with a game-high 19 points.

## NYL NEWS & NOTES

**SUMMER SERIES:** Tonight's game wraps the season series between New York and Washington ... With a Liberty win, it would be the second series tie in the all-time history against the Mystics ... If Washington scores the victory, it would be the fourth series win for the visitors and the first since 2004.

**CAREER NIGHT FOR COURAGEOUS CARSON:** Despite suffering a strained arch in the third quarter on Thursday night in Motown, guard Essence Carson returned in the final frame to help the Liberty battle back ... Carson poured in a career-high 28 points ... Thirteen of those points came in the fourth, including the game tying three-pointer to send the match-up into overtime ... She is the sixth player in franchise history to record 28 points in a single game ... It is the fifth highest individual scoring total for a Liberty player.

**FOURTH QUARTER FIGHT:** The Liberty trailed by 19 points on Thursday in Detroit, but used a tremendous fourth quarter comeback to tie the game with six seconds to go and sent the match-up into overtime ... New York scored a season-high 33 points in the final frame and season-high 50 second half points.

**RETURNING TO FORM:** In the last two seasons, New York has finished the regular season as one of the WNBA's top three three-point shooting teams ... New York knocked down 12 three-pointers in Detroit on Thursday ... It was the third time this summer (last: 7/23 vs. Monarchs) that the Liberty recorded that season-high from beyond-the-arc ... With a .444-percentage on the night, it was New York's best long range shooting performance this season.

**EARLY SUMMER EXIT:** With the loss against Connecticut on 9/4, the Liberty was eliminated from post-season contention ... It is just the fourth time in the history of the WNBA Playoffs that New York will not be represented ... The Liberty has a record nine post-season appearances along with Los Angeles, Sacramento and Houston.

**LAST TIME AROUND:** New York scored its first win of the summer against Washington at the Verizon Center on 8/16 as center Janel McCarville connected on a free throw with 9.1 seconds remaining to lift the Liberty over the Mystics ... She finished with a game-high 19 points.

**A VETERAN VAUGHN:** Center Kia Vaughn has turned in veteran performances over the past five games, averaging 21.1 mpg, 9.0 ppg and 3.0 rpg ... On Thursday in Detroit, she earned her first career start and netted eight of her career-high 15 points in the Liberty's fourth quarter comeback ... It was on 8/28 in Chicago that she recorded a career-high of nine rebounds ... New York's rookie has posted in double digits four times and led the team in rebounding three times this season.

**OVER THE LIMIT:** On Thursday in Detroit, the Liberty endured its fourth overtime game of the season and second in the last six days ... Four overtime games in one summer ties for the most in franchise history, having happened in 1999 and 2004 ... In those overtime match-ups, New York went 2-2 in both 1999 and 2004 ... This season, the Liberty is 1-3, having defeated the Sun at The Garden on 8/21.

**ENDING ON A HIGH NOTE:** The Liberty is 5-1 all-time when closing out the regular season on its home floor ... The lone loss came last year against the Shock ... Three of those five wins came against the Mystics ... New York is 5-7 overall in the final regular season match-up.

**ALL ABOUT THE FANS:** Tonight, the Liberty celebrates its loyal fan base as the season comes to a close by hosting its first ever "Fans' Choice Game" in conjunction with "Fan Appreciation Day" ... Fans chose all of the in-arena game elements, including the music played, dance routines, on-court contests during time-outs and much more via online voting.

### GAME 33: NY 87, DET 94 (OT)

Essence Carson sunk a three-pointer with six seconds remaining to tie the game at 84, which eventually led to overtime where the Liberty let the game slip away ... Deanna Nolan led the charge for the Shock in the extra period, nailing back-to-back three pointers to push the score to 84-90 with three minutes to go ... New York scored just once in overtime, on Sidney Spencer's trey with just over a minute to go and pulled the visitors within five points ... In the next possession, Carson snatched the ball from Nolan, but missed her shot attempt and fouled Shavonte Zellous on the rebound ... Zellous connected on both free throws to finish off the victory for Detroit ... Trailing by 10 points at halftime, the Liberty staged a strong fourth quarter comeback (33 points) to stay in the game ... Carson finished with a career-high 28 points and Kia Vaughn, in her first career start, added her own career-high of 15 points in the team's final road game of the season.

New York held a nine-point lead in the fourth quarter, but Connecticut kept the visitors scoreless for the final five minutes of the game ... Lindsay Whalen tied the game at 73 with one minute remaining ... The Liberty had four attempts to break the tie, but missed all of them ... Amber Holt attempted a three-pointer with 2.9 seconds to go, but the shot was off mark and the game was sent into overtime ... New York once again had a lead - going ahead by three points - twice in overtime ... Anete Jekabsone-Zogota sunk a three pointer with 1:54 remaining to tie the game at 80 ... Holt scored four straight points for the hosts for a five point advantage ... Shameka Christon was fouled shooting a three-pointer and made all her free throws with 8.9 seconds to go to bring the Liberty within one point ... Whalen was fouled on the other end of the floor in the next possession and sunk both free throws with 7.2 seconds in the game ... Sidney Spencer's three-point attempt with 0.2 seconds was a miss and time expired ... Christon finished with 22 points.
